Cookie Policy & Privacy Policy – English Language

Ristorante "Tre Camini" in this page, how it treats the data of users who visit his site and how they act cookies that are installed by the site itself.

This Privacy Policy is made in compliance with article 13 of the GDPR 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation), of the Recommendation no. 2/2001 of the Working Group pursuant to art. 29 and of the General Provision of the Privacy Guarantor concerning cookies of 8 May 2014, n. 229.

Privacy Policy

We process and use data that the user spontaneously inserts through the forms on the site (Contacts - Contact Form) solely to respond to your request.

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with some personally identifiable information that may be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Personal identification information may include:

- Email address
- Name and surname
- Telephone number (optional)

Our website does NOT store user data and the same, in any case, **are not used** to send information through newsletters or other web marketing systems.

Cookies:

They are collected for the purpose of the website operation:

- Cookies and usage data
- IP address

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies?

- if you have agreed (or not) to our use of cookies on this site

Also, some videos embedded in our pages use a cookie to anonymously gather statistics on how you got there and what videos you visited.

Enabling these cookies is not strictly necessary for the website to work but it will provide you with a better browsing experience. You can delete or block these cookies, but if you do that some features of this site may not work as intended.

The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally and the pattern data is fully under our control. These cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described here.

How to control cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see aboutcookies.org. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
